## New Committees Authorized

At its recent midyear meeting, the Executive Committee has approved the appointment of two new drafting committees and three new study committees. The first drafting committee will revise the intestacy provisions of the Uniform Probate Code and create a free-standing act on intestacy. The second drafting committee will be appointed to draft an act on the certification of unsworn foreign declarations.

The three new study committees will deal with (1) notice and opportunity to repair construction defects, (2) electronic recording of custodial interrogations, and (3) insurance coverage for substance abuse related injuries or sickness.

More information on these new committees will be available in the next quarterly newsletter, which will be sent out very soon.
